You can either cut out just the number; or cut out the number and information and then place/stick/pin over its square.

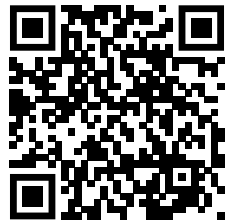
